

The Medical Radiation Practice Board of Australia (the Board) is calling for applications for multiple vacancies on its Accreditation Committee.

Applications are sought from:

- medical radiation practitioners in all divisions of registration who have current knowledge of the [capabilities required for practice](#) in the profession; and

- members of the community
 - with experience in education and/or assessment, and/or
 - currently holding a senior academic position in an Australian tertiary institution within the discipline of medical radiation science, and/or
 - who possess experience in accreditation of professional education in professions other than medical radiation practice.

Under its Terms of Reference the Accreditation Committee is responsible for:

- developing accreditation standards for medical radiation practice programs of study, for approval by the National Board.
- assessing and monitoring programs of study and education providers against the approved accreditation standard for medical radiation practice programs.

The Accreditation Committee is not responsible for setting registration standards, registering health practitioners, or investigating complaints about health practitioners.
